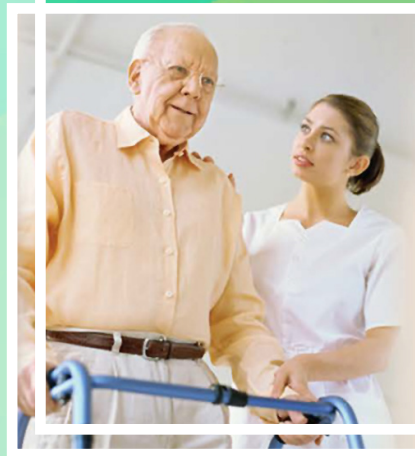
WHAT IS SKILLUP?

The program offers job search, training, education, and supportive services to participants. The SkillUP grant is administered by the Missouri Department of Social Services, Family Support Division and funded through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).
