- Replacement of the self-study
- Documentation of how the Criteria for Accreditation and Core Components are met
- Analytical and evaluative; supported by evidence
- Strong focus on assessment and quality assurance

- Documentation of how Jefferson meets federal compliance requirements
- Examples of federal compliance requirements:
 - Credit hour worksheet
 - Transfer policies
 - Title IV program responsibilities
 - Verification of student identity

Federal Compliance Filing Timeline

- AY2016
 - Convene Federal Compliance Task Force
 - Share draft Federal Compliance matrix
 - Prepare narratives for each federal requirement
- AY2017
 - Finalize Federal Compliance matrix
 - Draft Federal Compliance report
 - Prepare credit hour worksheet
- AY2018
 - Compile, review, and finalize Federal Compliance report

Quality Initiative

- To implement an attendance/participation tracking system to collect required data for Federal Financial Aid regulations and leverage the institutional committee structure to analyze data and submit action plans to implement student retention initiatives.
- Five-year initiative
- Phases

Quality Initiative Timeline

- AY2016
 - Host strategic planning retreat to discuss implementation of the Learning Analytics Processor (LAP)
 - Develop outreach initiatives
- AY2017
 - Implement the LAP
 - Identify at-risk students and perform intervention
 - Share progress updates with institutional committees
- AY2018
 - Evaluate the Quality Initiative
 - Prepare and submit Jefferson's Quality Initiative report
