



Jefferson College Bi-Level Nursing Program Clinical Requirements & Immunization Checklist

Urine Drug Screen – Mercy Occupational Health, 1390 Hwy 61 (3rd floor) Suite 3200, Festus, MO 63028 (636) 933-1669. **Screenings ONLY offered Monday-Friday from 8 a.m.-4 p.m.**

- Drug screen must be completed at the Mercy site above – (No Exceptions).
- **NOTE:** The Nursing Education Office will email a Medical Authorization form for each accepted applicant to Mercy Occupational Health; *this form is required for drug screening.*
 - Inform Mercy that you are a Jefferson College Bi-Level Nursing Student. *The fee for the urine drug screen is **included** in the nursing program fees.*
- Mercy Occupational Health is now at a new location within Mercy Hospital Jefferson: 1390 US Hwy 61 (3rd floor) Suite N3200, Festus, 63028 is the physical address; however, they are attached to the hospital.
- Mercy requests that anyone entering the building wears some type of face covering.
- Mercy is asking for students to **call ahead of time** with a time of arrival; this will keep from having too many people in the waiting room at any given time.
- When the students come to the hospital, they will want to go into the CLINIC ENTRANCE. Once inside, students will be asked a few questions and their temperature will be taken.
- Once students have completed the questionnaire and temperature monitoring, they will make a left and go to the end of the hall where there is an elevator on the left hand side.
- Take the elevator to the third floor; Mercy Occupational Health is located in suite N3200.

Physical Examination: Provide documentation of completed medical history and examination form signed by a medical professional (i.e. PCP, Chiropractor, Health Dept., et cetera). Applicants **must** utilize the form provided by the nursing department.

BLS-CPR: Provide a current AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION – Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers, Adult, Child & Infant CPR Certification with AED training.

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Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap): Provide documentation of **one (1) Tdap** vaccination administered within the last 10 years.

Varicella (Chicken Pox): Provide documentation of **two (2) doses** of varicella vaccine at least four (4) weeks apart, **or** titer showing immunity.

Hepatitis B Series: Provide documentation of **three (3) vaccinations or** titer showing immunity. This is a **three (3) vaccine series** that will take a total of 6 months to complete. The first vaccine must be initiated by set due date. The remainder of the series may be completed while in the program.

Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR): Provide documentation of **two (2) doses** of MMR vaccine at least four (4) weeks apart, **or** titer showing immunity to Measles, Mumps, and Rubella.

Tuberculosis (TB): Documentation of any of the following is acceptable:

- Negative TB blood test (*ex. Quantiferon Gold, T-Spot, Interferon Gamma Release Assay-IGRA*)
- Two consecutive annual One-step TB skin tests (PPD) with negative results
- Negative Two-step TB skin test (PPD) (total of 4 visits-*see example below*)
- Negative chest x-ray must be documented if blood or skin test are positive

Example of two-step TB skin test (PPD)

First visit: PPD #1 administered on June 2	Second visit: PPD #1 read on June 4
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*The second PPD must be completed at least seven (7) days **after** the first PPD but **no more than** twenty-one (21) days after the first PPD.*

Third visit: PPD #2 administered on June 16	Fourth visit: PPD #2 read on June 18
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Flu Vaccination: Provide documentation of flu shot administered during the **current** flu season

The Level I/PN and Level II/RN programs have full approval from the Missouri State Board of Nursing (MSBN).
