This course examines the skill sets of how to debrief three possible situations involving a squad or platoon of officers/deputies.

Course Description:

1. Following a critical incident: How to engage reflective and critical thinking, recognition of quality work and identification of other options for handling aspects requiring change.
2. Following the serious injury or death of a fellow officer/deputy: Speaking with those on the shift, on the scene and tele-communicators that handled the call.
3. Following a Use of Force Incident that may have involved multiple officers/deputies on the scene.

This course will include supervision coaching/facilitation skills to help officers/deputies feel comfortable in speaking freely towards increasing their observation, thinking and decision making to avoid unnecessary violence and lawsuit.
