Course Description:

Law Enforcement agencies need a broad range of training programs to prepare officers/deputies to safely handle the many dangers they face. Vehicle related deaths, injuries and the accompanying liability can be reduced by safe driver training and using better driving practices. In this course you will learn the skills and techniques to help prevent collisions and violations. You will learn to identify the common types of driving errors that contribute to collisions and the emotions, risky driving behavior and attitudes that contribute to accidents. During this training you will learn the characteristics of a defensive driver, the objectives of emergency vehicle operation, the siren syndrome and its effects on the driver, the issues that need to be considered before initiating a vehicular pursuit, the objective of emergency response driving and the three personal factors involved in emergency response driving.

During this training time will be spent in the classroom and using the driver simulators. Use of the driver simulators will provide an opportunity to practice speed and space management, split second judgment and decision making, hazard perception and practice multi-tasking.
