Course Description:

This training will cover updates in juvenile law and procedure. The training will begin with a review of the role of the Deputy Juvenile Officer. We will cover areas concerning In-Custody Matters: Proper questioning of juveniles, when to Mirandize a juvenile and how probable cause affects the detention of a juvenile. We will discuss how to properly prepare a report, the information it should contain and the time frame concerning juveniles who are detained. We will cover when a juvenile may be fingerprinted and the procedure for referring a case to the Child Advocacy Center (CAC). We will discuss Minor In Possession cases as well as Status Offenses and what resources are available.

Information will be provided to better understand the scoring system used in the detention of a juvenile. We will also review what happens after a report is turned in to the Juvenile Office on a typical case. Finally, we will review typical case examples that process through the system.
