Day classes –

Meets Monday - Friday, 8:00 am - 3:30 pm.

This course begins in August and ends by the following May [two college semesters]. *Applications due mid-June**

Night classes –

Meets Monday – Thursday, 6:00 pm 10:00 p.m. and selected 8-hour Saturdays per month.

This course is January through December each year [three college semesters]. *Applications due mid-November**

P.O.S.T. Only classes –

Meets Monday – Thursday, 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and selected 8-hour Saturdays per month.

This course begins in October and ends in July of the following year [an eight-month timeframe].

Must have specific general education credits, a 2-year, 4-year or greater degree to apply to the POST Only program.

*Applications due mid-August**
