Intended Audience: Law Enforcement personnel who desire to be a patrol rifle instructor

The 40 Hour Patrol Rifle (AR-15) Instructor Course will certify the participating officer to instruct Patrol Rifle training to their departments. This course will cover the basics of range management and safety, classroom instruction and safety. In order to be certified; the officer must demonstrate safe firearms handling in class and on the range, participate in classroom and range instruction and demonstrations, present a lecture presentation on an assigned topic and successfully pass a 60 round rifle qualification course at the end of training.

Course Description: Candidates for this class should be advanced firearms marksmen.

TRAINING REQUIRES: Operable patrol rifle with iron sights and rifle sling, shooting mat, 1000 rounds of factory new/duty carry rifle ammunition, four 20 or 30 round rifle magazines, service pistol with minimum of 3 magazines, 250 rounds of factory new/duty carry pistol ammunition complete duty belt, department body armor, personal protective equipment (eyes & ears), gun cleaning kit for rifle and handgun.
