Details: Reynolds County Ambulance District (RCAD) is looking for full time or PRN PARAMEDICS. Full time medics will work either a fixed (same days every week) 48- or 72-hour shift once a week and PRN medics are welcome to pick up whatever shifts available.

Reynolds County is located approx. 45 minutes south of Farmington and services areas such as Johnson Shut Ins and Mark Twain National Forest.

The county is classified as "very rural" and the job entails the implementation of ALL of a paramedics skills and knowledge along with the frequent use of air EMS.

A 72-hour medic will earn approx. 45k a year depending on OT and a 48-hour medic approx. 35k once again depending on OT.

In the upcoming year a rescue squad will be formed with motivated employees receiving training for high angle, low angle, and water rescue. There is also the option of doing a "flip" shift, example: week 1 you work Monday/Tuesday and Friday/Saturday, followed by week 2 working Wednesday/Thursday and then repeat.
