The University of Missouri–St. Louis offers benefit-eligible employees a wide variety of benefits including:

- Health, dental and vision coverage effective on the first day of employment
- Employee assistance program
- Personal, vacation and sick time accrual
- Tuition assistance for employees and their dependents
- Participation in public service loan forgiveness program (if eligible)
- Defined contribution plan (100% university match up to 8% of eligible compensation: three-year vesting period)

- Every UMSL Police Officer is CIT trained and certified within their year of employment. (Crisis Intervention Team- for those experiencing a crisis and mental health issues)
