The testing fee is \$40; students will be responsible for the \$40 re-testing fee if 80% is not achieved on the initial attempt. Once the exam has been passed, a posting fee equivalent to one credit hour of tuition will be charged for adding the computer literacy proficiency to the student's transcript.

**** Students who graduate with 12 or more credit hours of Jefferson College honors courses and have attained a 2.5 GPA in the honors courses and at least a 3.3 cumulative GPA at graduation will be awarded an Honors Program Diploma. All Honors program graduates' names will be placed on a plaque in the Honors Resource Room, and all will be given purple cords of distinction to wear at Commencement ceremonies.
