## Instructions for Graduates

- Line up in alphabetical order by last name (A-L Blue Line & M-Z Red Line).
- Look for signs on walls to find your letter, or ask a worker in a red vest.
- Hang on to the name card you will be given.
- If you have "Summa Cum Laude" on your card, move to the front of the blue line regardless of your last name.
- When processional begins walk slowly. You will be seated in rows of ten.
- If you are handed a "start a new row" paper, show it to the person assisting with seating you on the floor so they know to move you to a new row.
- After processional, remain standing until instructed to be seated after the national anthem.
- You will be released by rows to your left to approach the stage line.
- Outstanding Achievement grads (summa grads) will be the last group instructed to approach the stage.
- Take your name card with you. Wait on the top step until your name is called.
- Cross the stage, accept your diploma cover and pause briefly for a picture.
  Exit the stage and the photographer will take a picture of you.
- Return to your row and remain until the end of the ceremony. Marshals and red vested workers will guide you.
- When the ceremony ends, you will be released one row at a time into the lobby or out a side exit door to the front patio area. Please move through the lobby and outside to meet your party to avoid crowding the exit of the line.
- A photo backdrop is set up in the lobby for pictures.

## **After Commencement**

- Grades and transcripts will not be available until May 22nd. Degrees may take 6-8 weeks to be posted and mailed to you. Keep your address current.
- Transcripts may be requested via the Jefferson College website. Please check "wait for grade posting" or "wait for degree posting" if applicable. If you do not check this, transcripts will go be sent without these updates.
