CNA (Certified Nursing Assistant)

The CNA program teaches basic nursing care skills for residents in long-term care facilities under supervision. Upon completion, students can take the Missouri state exams for certification. The program offers four pathways for students to choose from.

CMT (Certified Medication Technician)

This program prepares individuals for employment as CMTs in nursing facilities. It teaches skills for administering non-parenteral medications, enabling students to assist licensed practical nurses or registered nurses in medication therapy.

MA (Medical Assistant)

Medical Assistants are vital to healthcare operations, providing patient care and managing tasks like obtaining vital signs, administering medications, performing wound care, assisting in procedures, conducting EKGs, and handling medical records and health insurance.
