Employer Pay

Employers may cover program costs by submitting a letter of intent with student name, program, dates, and payment amount.

Fast Track Workforce Inventive Grant

Applicants must be Missouri residents, U.S. citizens, age 25+, and have completed a FAFSA.

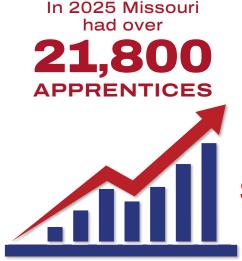
What is an Apprenticeship?

Benefits of an Apprenticeship:

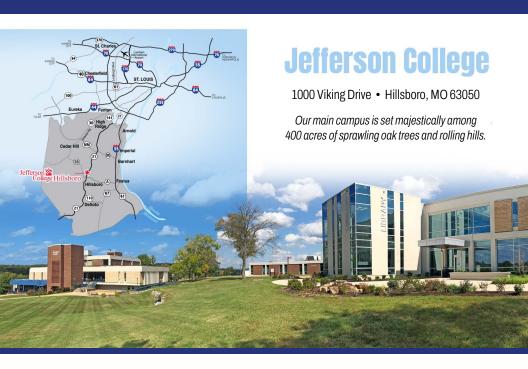
- **Get paid while you learn**, with wages that increase over time.
