The Office of Research & Planning furthers the mission of the college by collecting and analyzing data and producing meaningful information for use by administrators, faculty and staff, to increase institutional effectiveness and student success. Examples of projects undertaken include Institutional Assessment requests, Strategic Planning initiatives and continual key performance indicator updates, multiple data requests to analyze the revised course placement and new reading requirements, and subject area instructor course grade distributions to facilitate academic program planning and improvement.

The Office of Research & Planning supports the Strategic Plan through our commitment to and support of the College's strategic aims, including Student Learning, Student Support, Community Collaboration, Support for Employees, Facilities and Infrastructure, Financial Responsibility, and Assessment. This office provides data updates, reports and services that support and directly relate to each of these aims.

Accomplishments & Significant Changes

The Office of Research & Planning continues to perform the responsibilities of the Institutional Data Coordinator in an accurate and timely manner, provide data in support of Institutional Assessment activities through annual Factbooks and ad-hoc data requests, manage and support campus surveying, and support the Strategic Planning Committee's efforts to coordinate and provide data for bench-marking Key Performance Indicators.

In July, 2010, with the retirement of the Director of Research & Planning, the Research Assistant was promoted to Research Analyst, and this office now employs only one person. In order to compensate for the cut in staff/resources, Perkins reporting is no longer reported from the Office of Research & Planning. Additionally, the federal reporting responsibilities for the Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act and the Clery Act (Annual Security & Fire Safety) have both been assigned to the corresponding campus director/supervisor, although the Federal Disclosures and campus reporting procedures for each of these federal requirements remains within the Office of Research & Planning.

The Research Council was developed in Fall, 2010, in hopes to implement cohesion among research and data efforts across campus. The Research Council is chaired by the Research Analyst, who continues to define, sharpen, and implement the actions and future direction of the group.

<u>Staff</u>

The staff consists of one Research Analyst, who has been employed in this office for 15 years. She has received generous institutional support through tuition reimbursement which allowed her to earn her Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology in October 2012.

With the recent restructuring of Institutional Committees, the Research Analyst serves on the following committees: Accreditation, Assessment, Events & Community Outreach, Strategic Enrollment Management and Retention, Strategic Planning, and numerous subcommittees. Additionally, the Research Analyst continues to coordinate the annual Jefferson College Commencement and serve as the campus MCCA Membership Chair.

Products & Services

During the period of this program review, the Office of Research & Planning has worked cooperatively to produce timely information for campus committees, departments and personnel, supporting such primary campus activities as budgeting, enrollment management, assessment, program review, retention efforts, quality improvement, student satisfaction survey administration, and strategic planning. In its capacity of data keyholder, this office continues to provide mandated data to the Missouri Department of Higher Education, the U.S. Department of Education and the Higher Learning Commission.

In addition to the products and services listed above, the Office of Research & Planning began to formally track office data requests in 2010. 129 projects were completed in 2010, 143 were completed in 2011 and 136 were completed in 2012.

Annual Cost per FTE and Trend Analyses

The data presented above represents a small portion of the work generated in the Office of Research & Planning over the past five years. As the figures indicate, the workload in the Office of Research & Planning has not declined significantly with the retirement of its director and loss of half its staff. From August 2010 through December 2011, the office continued to employ the retired director on a part-time basis to help with the responsibilities of the office. However, beginning in January, 2012, the office has been operating with only one staff member, and no director.

The following tables and chart reflect the Office of Research & Planning's expenditures per FTE student and annual operating expenditures.
