that *he*... be and appear before our Circuit Court of the county of Jefferson, on the first day of the next term thereof, to be holden at the Court House in Hillsboro, in said county of Jefferson, on the *first* day of *March* next, then and there to answer the petition of *Joseph J. Williams*

wherein *he*... asks judgment for _____ dollars and _____ cents, and that you also summon _____

Two Hundred and Twenty

and all other persons that you shall find in the possession of goods, money or effects of the defendant, not actually seized by you, and all debtors of the defendant, and such other persons as the plaintiff or his attorney shall direct, as garnishees, to be and appear before our said court, at the time and place aforesaid, then and there to answer such allegations and interrogatories as may be exhibited against them; and have you then and there this writ.
